

Dear Senior Students and Parents:

Woodbury High School staff would like to support our high achieving students as they are enrolled in rigorous coursework and are preparing for AP exams in the spring. As a result, students will be allowed to take an AP study hall if the student needs additional time to prepare for exams while taking a full rigorous course load. The purpose of the AP study hall is to give students additional time to prepare for AP exams and to provide additional homework/study time for students taking multiple rigorous courses.

The criteria for an AP study hall period will be:

- Senior students only (Juniors will be allowed only if they have 3 or more AP/CIS classes)
- Students must be currently enrolled in 3 or more AP or CIS classes
- Available during trimesters 2 & 3
- Seniors must drop an elective class, which is not needed for graduation
- Students are expected to leave campus or remain in the cafeteria during their AP study hall period
- Students will not earn a credit for this AP study hall period
- AP study hall period will not appear on your transcript

We will need parent permission to allow students to make this schedule change and either work in the cafeteria or leave campus during this class period.

If you and your AP student feel this would be of benefit, please have them bring this signed form to their counselor to make the necessary changes to their schedule. Remember, students will have to drop one of their trimester 2 and/or trimester 3 elective classes.

I give my student permission to study in the cafeteria or leave campus during their AP study hall period. I am aware an elective will be dropped from their schedule and no credit will be awarded for this course.
